BOARD OF TRANSPORTATION MEETING

January 4, 2018

Call to Order

Chairman Fox called the meeting of the Board of Transportation to order at 9:00 a.m. on Thursday, January 4, 2018, in Raleigh, North Carolina with the following members present: Moran, Jordan, Hunt, Fox, Molamphy, Dodson, Lathrop, and Tarleton.

Board Members Overholt, Tulloss, Szlosberg-Landis, Hutchens, Wells, Perkins and Pope called in to the meeting.

Board Members Zimmer, Clarke and Debnam were absent.

Ethics Statement

Chairman Fox read the Ethics Statement advising any Board member that may have a conflict of interest or appearance of conflict to abstain from participation in that particular item and to file the proper paper work with the Secretary to the Board.

Approval – Minutes of the December 7, 2017, Board Meeting

The minutes of the December 7, 2017, Board of Transportation meeting were unanimously approved upon a motion by Board Member Tarleton, seconded by Board Member Moran.

Approval – Minutes of the December 6, 2017, Closed Session Board Meeting

The minutes of the December 6, 2017, Closed Session Board of Transportation meeting were unanimously approved upon a motion by Board Member Lathrop, seconded by Board Member Tarleton.

Resolution for Ambassador Mattie R. Sharpless

Chairman Fox noted that the Resolution naming a portion of US 17 from Union Bethel Road (SR 1562) to the Onslow and Pender County line as the Ambassador Mattie R. Sharpless Highway has been postponed to the February 1, 2018, meeting due to the weather as the Ambassador and guests were unable to attend.

Resolution for First Lieutenant Guy J. Winstead

Board Member Jordan presented the Resolution naming a section of NC Highway 57 between Thomas Road (SR 1200) and the intersection of Concord Church Road (SR 1300) and Concord Ceffo Road (SR 1340) as the First Lieutenant Guy J. Winstead Highway. The Resolution was unanimously approved upon a motion by Board Member Jordan and seconded by Board Member Tarleton.

Resolution for Conley Call

Board member Tarleton presented the Resolution naming a portion of NC 268 beginning at the intersection of NC 18 and ending at the North Wilkesboro city limits as the Conley Call Highway. The Resolution was unanimously approved upon a motion by Board Member Tarleton and seconded by Board Member Moran.

Chairman's Remarks

Chairman Fox welcomed all guests and turned the meeting over to Chief Operating Officer Bobby Lewis who will be reading Secretary Trogdon's remarks. The Chairman noted that the Secretary is working with Governor Cooper for a briefing due to the Winter Weather.

Chief Operating Officer's Remarks

Chief Operating Officer Bobby Lewis read Secretary Trogdon's remarks and welcomed the Board Members. He noted it was good to be back to kick off the New Year and get to work building on the momentum from last year. He stated that when Governor Cooper took office, he laid out his goals to help all North Carolina families and move the state forward.

He noted that the administration hit the ground running with tangible results. The state announced 21,000 new jobs in 2017 -- the most recruited in any one year since 2006. This success is in part due to a closely coordinated recruiting process that DOT is a part of.

Mr. Lewis reported that Hurricane Matthew recovery is another example. The storm caused \$4 billion in damage across 50 counties. More than 660 roads on state system were damaged -- 600 were closed at peak of flooding. He stated that when we came in in January, about 130 were still closed. In less than 6 weeks, 100 of those were reopened. Only one remains closed (environmentally complex bridge replacement at Falls Lake)

Mr. Lewis noted that Board Members have a copy of the Department's Annual Performance Report for 2017. It outlines how we performed for the 2016/2017 fiscal year – which is July 1, 2016 through June 30, 2017. It also includes our enhanced performance measures for 2017/2018.

Mr. Lewis noted that some highlights include: focusing on program delivery, not just project delivery; moving from doing tasks sequentially to simultaneously; adjusting for current market revenue/cost conditions; and the creation of Division Mobility and Modernization Funds. He also stated that additional highlights include that the Department worked with General Assembly to establish the Roadside Environmental Fund. The fund provides \$104 million for each year in the biennium dedicated for vegetation management, mowing, litter prevention and removal, beautification efforts and Rest Areas.

He reported that we had a good start in 2017, but we have much more to do in 2018.

Mr. Lewis stated that the Department will continue to support Governor Cooper's efforts to move North Carolina forward by building on our work to better serve our citizens. To accomplish this, he stated that the Department will continue to focus on the goals and priorities that he previously laid out: reducing fatal crashes, accelerating projects in the transportation improvement program and, in turn, reducing our cash balance by half; improving mobility and reducing congestion; improving the appearance and condition of our bridges and highways; and preparing for future technologies on our transportation system, as well as embracing them to improve our performance.

He stated that in addition to these areas, the Department also will focus on: Addressing revenue challenges -- demands are increasing, while resources are declining and we must begin studying for long-term future funding in transportation. He also stated that the Department is tracking changes implemented in 2017 to make sure we are meeting project delivery targets (develop dashboard to track changes).

Mr. Lewis stated that the Department has a dedicated and talented team that is committed to serving the people of North Carolina. He noted that the Department got off to a good start in 2017, but we are going to do even better in 2018. He thanked the Board Members for their continued support toward our goals in the coming year.

Chairman Fox noted that Department of Environmental Quality Secretary Michael S. Regan will provide his Department Update in the Spring as he is unable to attend the meeting due to the weather.

Approval of Projects

A motion was made by Board Member Tarleton, seconded by Board Member Moran to approve all the projects, excluding items C, D, E, H and L as they are delegated authority items and require no Board action.

Board Member Lathrop abstained from voting on all projects at the January 4, 2018, Board of Transportation Meeting.

Delegated Authority Items

Approval -- Award of Highway Construction Contracts from December 2017 Letting Projects were awarded by the Secretary to the low bidder on all projects.
