Notes for Calculating Billing

Syncrolift:

Each occurrence is billed at \$6,000 per use. Haul out is \$6,000 and launch is \$6,000. Total \$12,000 for a drydocking event. Fleeting or shifting a vessel would be an additional \$12,000.

Blocking:

Calculate using the total length of the vessel.

Crane, Forklift, Man-Scissor lift:

Charged by the day only. No partial or hourly rates.

Personnel Services:

Total hours used based on rates above. Rates are calculated off actual cost plus 15%.

Materials:

Actual cost plus 20%

Dry Docking Space:

Time starts the day the vessel is hauled up to and including the day it is launched. Flat fee of \$500 per day, regardless of the length of vessel.

Dockside in Basin:

Any day or partial day vessel is tied up in basin. \$35.00 per foot of total length of vessel per day.

Shore Power:

\$200 per connection and \$200 per disconnection at any location.

Utilities: Flat rate of \$125 per day for entire stay of vessel. (Electricity, air, water etc.)

Overboard Fueling: Any overboard fueling when oil boom is deployed \$350

Gangway: \$400 per occurrence per gangway. (Crane included)
