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Board of Transportation Meeting

May 1, 2014

Call to Order

Chairman Curran called the meeting of the Board of Transportation to order at 8:33 a.m. Thursday, May 1, 2014 in Raleigh, North Carolina with the following members present:

Invocation

The invocation was offered by Board Member Kernea.

Approval – Minutes of the April 3, 2014 Board Meeting

The minutes of the April 3, 2014 Board of Transportation meeting were unanimously approved upon a motion by Board Member Palermo, seconded by Board Member McQueary.

Ethics Statement

Chairman Curran read the Ethics Statement advising any Board Member that may have a conflict of interest or appearance of conflict to abstain from participation in that particular item and to file the proper paper work with the Secretary to the Board.

Secretary's Remarks

Secretary Tata welcomed everyone to Raleigh. The Secretary travelled with Governor McCrory on Sunday to see firsthand the destruction in Beaufort, Perquimans, and Chowan counties as a result of the severe weather. NCDOT employees in the affected and nearby divisions have been assisting with cleanup efforts. Secretary Tata noted the employees not only build roads, but they respond to emergencies. He thanked the employees for their hard work.

The Secretary introduced the Department's new Chief Financial Officer David Tyeryar. Mr. Tyeryar previously served as Deputy Secretary and Chief Financial Officer for the Virginia Department of Transportation, which has faced and continues to face similar funding challenges to those faced by NCDOT and other DOT's across the nation. Mr. Tyeryar helped pass Virginia's first comprehensive transportation funding plan in 27 years that provides more than 13,000 jobs and \$9.5 billion in economic investments. He also helped establish the Department's office of Public Private Partnerships, which resulted in more than \$5 billion in projects using less than \$1 billion in state funds. NCDOT continues to look at ways to be more innovative with existing resources and to utilize alternative financing methods, and Mr. Tyeryar's experience will be critical as the Department moves forward with these efforts.

Secretary Tata announced that Paul Cozza has been hired as the new State Ports Executive Director. Mr. Cozza brings extensive experience and leadership in international shipping and logistics to his new role. He will be instrumental in enhancing our state's ports.

The Secretary congratulated Board Members Jake Alexander and Jim Crawford on their recent appointments to the Turnpike Authority Board of Directors. The Secretary is pleased to have both of these gentlemen serve the Department and state in this new capacity. The Ports Authority Board of Directors has three new appointees: Holly Grange of New Hanover County; Bill Keadey, Jr. of Carteret County; and Bill McMahon, III of Mecklenburg County. Secretary Tata extended his congratulations to all the new Board members and thanked them for their service.

Secretary Tata shared exciting news about moving forward with the state's first major Public Private Partnership (P3) concession agreement for managed lanes along the I-77 corridor in the Charlotte area. The apparent successful bidder for the project, Cintra Infraestructuras, S.A., will construct the project through a joint venture with F.A. Southeast, W. C. English, and lead design firm The Louis Berger Group. NCDOT's contribution toward the \$655 million project is only \$88 million, which is significantly less than the \$170 million that had been projected. Without the Public Private Partnership, the Department estimated it would have cost NCDOT about \$550 million to construct the project. The agreement is expected to be signed in June, with construction beginning as early as this December and with an expected completion date in 2018.

The Secretary announced that on Tuesday, President Obama introduced a bill called the GROW AMERICA Act which he is sending to Congress for their consideration. The bill would reauthorize surface transportation funding for four years, which would help alleviate some of the funding uncertainty we are currently facing. About one quarter of NCDOT's budget and about half of the construction program budget is funded through federal funds. Without action, North Carolina alone will lose more than 20,000 jobs, and vital transportation needs will go undelivered.

Secretary Tata noted that the Department is moving forward with the implementation of the Strategic Transportation Investment (STI). At the end of March, the preliminary data for the nearly 1,300 highway projects that were already in the database was released. On May 14, the Department will release the preliminary data for the roughly 500 new highway projects submitted by transportation planning organizations and NCDOT Divisions, as well as about 1,300 non-highway projects. The release of this data is a step in the new process and does not determine whether a project will ultimately be programmed or funded. Local input, which is factored into the overall scores of projects in the Regional and Division categories, must also be assigned in the 90 days following the release of this date before final scores and rankings can be determined.

The Secretary announced that he would be joining the Governor and Commissioner Thomas to officially open the new Huntersville DMV office later today. He thanked the entire DMV team for the outstanding work that has been done over the past 15 months to improve customer service at DMV's

across the state and introduce a wide range of new initiatives. In closing, he asked Deputy Commissioner Randy Dishong to come forward for a brief presentation on DMV Reform.

DMV Reform

Deputy Commissioner Randy Dishong provided an update on DMV reform.

Board Member David Brown provided a PowerPoint presentation to share concerns and challenges in Division thirteen.

This Supplemental Agreement No. 3 covers the amendment of the Preliminary Engineering Reimbursement Agreement (PERA) to provide for an increase in funding for projects covered by the agreement. It also covers the amendment for the scope of work to include the design and plan review for the McLeansville Road Grade Separation Project as part of the Piedmont Improvement Project (PIP). The increased estimated cost to the Department is \$4,810,275 which includes \$15,300.00 for the McLeansville Road Grade Separation Project. The Department, NSR, and NCRR executed the PERA on December 21, 2011.

North Carolina Dept. of Cultural Resources

This Agreement (MOU) covers the process by which NCDOT will receive donations for "Art That Moves You" projects and the reimbursement of funds to NCDOT for specified projects. The scope of work, deliverables, delivery timeline and funding of projects will be included in a separate MOA.
