N.C. Transportation Summit



DMV Saturday Hours

The N.C. Division of Motor Vehicles has resumed <u>Saturday hours</u> at 16 driver license offices across the state.

Services will be provided from 8 a.m. - noon Saturdays through Aug. 24.

Customers are still encouraged to utilize the NCDMV's online services for various needs, including but not limited to renewing or ordering duplicates of driver licenses and ID cards, address changes and voter registration cards.



New NCDMV Credentials

New driver licenses, permits, and identification cards will now feature the latest in card security design and construction specifically designed to combat fraud.

The state's new credential is a 100% polycarbonate card that is personalized using laser engraving technology and contains more than 50 security features to assist law

enforcement in the deterrence and detection of fraud.

The current design will be phased out by the end of June, but current licenses and ID cards will remain valid until their expiration date.

Contract Applications Sought to Operate Lincolnton License Plate Agency

The N.C. Division of Motor Vehicles is seeking applicants to operate a license plate agency (LPA) in Lincolnton.

In North Carolina, NCDMV oversees LPAs, but the agencies are managed by private businesses or local governments. The current agency, at 2683 East Main Street, will close on September 19, 2024, when the current contractor retires. Matthew Craig has operated this office since December 2020.
