HOW ARE THE OVERALL DBE GOALS SET?



OVERVIEW – DBE GOALS

The *current* NCDOT 3-year schedule began with FY 2022 (October 1, 2021) and goes through FY 2024 (September 30, 2024).

The new goals submission due date for FY 2025-2027, will be prior to December 1, 2024.

A DBE goal setting methodology is a **process** required in 49 CFR Part 26.45 of the DBE Regulations

REVIEW OF THE FFY 2025-2027 DBE GOAL METHODOLOGY-FHWA FUNDED PROJECTS

GOAL SETTING PROCESS: The COMPONENTS

- Begins with a List of proposed projects for the <u>next</u> three federal fiscal years
- Consideration of a Detailed BUDGET with cost breakdowns of major project components
- Identification of primary market area [the State of North Carolina]
- Analysis of *relative availability* of DBEs compared to all businesses, to perform the projects
- Application of a Two-Step Process: Calculation of a Base Figure (Step 1), and consideration of an "adjustment", (Step 2), which becomes the "Final" goal.

DBE GOALS SETTING – PREMISES

49 CFR Part 26: 45 (b) Goals should be determined by some reference or analysis of the *relative availability* of qualified firms in the relevant industries (or work codes), compared to "ALL" firms.

Ultimately, <u>overall goals</u> should represent the level of DBE participation a recipient would expect <u>absent</u> discrimination, and must be based on <u>evidence</u> of the availability of ready, willing and able DBEs in the local market area

STEP 1: GOALS – EXAMPLE OF APPROACH SELECTED

1. Use of Current NCDOT Directory, for "Relative Availability" Data, i.e. DBEs and "ALL firms.

2. Estimated Total 36-mo. Budget for projects Statewide, based on a Sample of Project TYPES.
3. And the use of Weighting, a mathematical tool.

FINAL STEP 1 DBE GOAL

Final Step One Base Goal Calculation, using Alternative # 5:

Project Category Analysis – to derive Aggregated Step 1- DBE Goal → 14.18%

OVERALL GOAL CALCULATION - STEP 2, **GOAL ADJUSTMENT**

The Regulations (49 CFR Part 26.45(d))

You must consider additional factors: e.g.

- **Current Capacity** of DBEs to perform work, as indicated by *recent historic attainment*
- Evidence from **disparity studies**, if available (and not used elsewhere)
- Statistical disparities in ability of DBEs to secure financing, bonding, and insurance
- Data on employment, self-employment, education, training programs
- **Any other data** that would help to better measure the percentage of work that DBEs would be likely to obtain in the absence of discrimination

STEP 2: GOAL ADJUSTMENT: PRIMARY CONSIDERATION IS "PRIOR ATTAINMENT"

The final PROPOSED OVERALL GOAL is the Step 1 goal (14.18%) averaged by the recent historic attainment figures:

1. 14.18% (Step 1) + 11.2% (Step 2) = 25.38/2 = <u>12.69%</u> or: <u>12.70%</u>

2. <u>This is the proposed overall 3-year goal to be</u> <u>submitted to the Federal Highway</u> <u>Administration</u>
